Tying instructions

The KMC pullover carrier and KMC tube carrier place the baby in a good kangaroo position. The baby is held in a huddled position (with bent arms and legs), with the tip of the baby's breastbone against that of the parent. Furthermore, the baby should also have good support for its head, so that it receives support for a position with a straight throat and torso, not bent.

1.

Put on the tube and place the baby so that its head rests against your chest. Pull up the tube so that half of the baby's head is covered by the upper edge of the tube. Then put on the pullover.



2.

Take one band of the pullover and thread it through the hole on the opposite side under the arm.



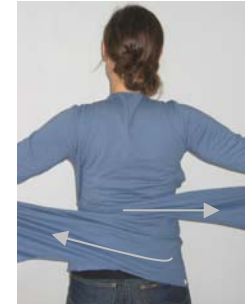
3.

Adjust the front piece by stretching and pulling it firmly.



4.

Take the other band and meet the first one behind your back..



5.

Bring the bands to the front again.



6.

Take the bands behind you again and tie behind your back.



7.

Smooth out the bands over the baby's back to give extra support.



8.

The pullover is now tied and is ready to be used. Note the importance of checking the baby's position. It is the person carrying the baby that is responsible for the baby's safety.
